MARKET SCENARIO

The Ghana construction market size is estimated at USD 11.3 billion in 2022, grown from 2013 at a CAGR of 13.2% and expected to grow at 5-7% annually for next 5-7 years too.

The key sectors in the Ghana construction market are commercial construction, industrial construction, infrastructure construction, energy and utilities construction, institutional construction, and residential construction. Infrastructure construction was the leading sector in the Ghana construction market in 2022.

The construction sector in Ghana appears to be performing well, accounts for more than 15% of the country's annual GDP and employs approximately 420,000 people.

It is estimated that 2,500 active building and construction contractors are working in Ghana. These include micro-enterprises and individual contractors to foreign multinational civil engineering and construction giants.

The Ghanaian government has also implemented a number of policies such as "One District, One Factory" and the "Agenda III" hospitals project which have attracted local and foreign investors, leading to the emergence of several construction companies.

The building materials industry in Ghana (excluding cement) was approximately USD 3.8 billion at the end of 2021. Of this figure, ceramics and roofing sheets together contributed \$ 1.3 billion (about 33% of the industry).

Activity within the sector is driven largely by the rate of activities in the real estate market and the current demand for housing for the working and middle classes of the population. In Ghana, the rapid population growth, high rate of urbanization and a growing housing deficit has resulted in a high demand for housing units and growth in the real estate sector.

The business community is urging for more reliable and affordable energy to support the country's push for a "24-hour economy."

Speaking on the sidelines of Power Energy Ghana Expo and BuildExpo Ghana 2025, Ghana Union of Traders Association (GUTA) President Joseph Obeng highlighted mounting concerns over high energy costs, which he said are burdening manufacturers and traders as they seek to expand.

Obeng stressed that as Ghana accelerates its industrialisation agenda, access to energy that is both dependable and affordable is non-negotiable.

24-Hour Economy is a business revolution, not just extended working hours – Mahama

"In our quest to industrialise as a nation, it is very important that we have affordable energy sources; otherwise, our efforts will be in vain due to competition with the rest of the world. It is crucial for us to access affordable energy rather than relying on old and obsolete sources that produce energy at higher costs," he stated.

As part of its recommendations, GUTA is advocating for greater adoption of renewable energy solutions, noting that clean energy must become more accessible and cost-effective for Ghanaian businesses.

The association has previously highlighted solar and other alternatives as critical to reducing operational pressures on enterprises and positioning the country for sustained economic growth.
